Legal Updates

Sienkiewicz v Greif (UK) Ltd - Judgment Awaited

This matter relates to a Mesothelioma claim in which the Court of Appeal concluded that a claimant need only establish that exposure to asbestos at work materially increased the risk of developing Mesothelioma as opposed to the argument that mesothelioma can develop naturally as a result of environmental exposure.

The defendants have referred the matter to the Supreme Court to which this latest challenge is yet another in a series of cases in which defendants have sought to find a basis for resisting asbestos claims. The decision of the Lord Justices is presently awaited.

Baker v Quantum Clothing Ltd - Judgment Awaited

This is a claim for industrial deafness currently awaiting judgment from the Supreme Court.

The issue with this matter is whether the employer is liable for damage to the employees hearing at a level previously deemed safe.

If the Defendant is successful in this matter then the number of Claimants able to bring claim for industrial deafness in the future will be fewer as the safety level will once again be raised.
